People who have watched the television series *The Chosen* over the past few years may have a clear picture in mind of the upcoming Gospel reading from John about a wedding in Cana of Galilee. The story is familiar. There was a problem as the wine being offered to the wedding guests was running low. In that setting running out wine, or for that matter having anything occur that would upset the festive spirit, was considered a bad sign for the newly married couple. As the story is told, Jesus's mother understood what was at stake and talked to Jesus. As Jesus's mother, she holds an important position in Jesus's life. When she told Jesus that the wine had run out, he responded to her in a way that might be off-putting to the modern reader. Basically, Jesus told his mother, whom he referred to as "woman," that running out of wine was not his concern.
